## Car Tax Relief

After hearing from concerned residents about property taxes, Ryan has worked to cut car taxes across the district for the last two years. He has put more than \$2 million back in the pockets of taxpayers and more than 8,000 cars in the district are no longer taxed at all.

## School Construction

A graduate of Cumberland public schools, Ryan led a legislative effort that resulted in a \$1 billion plan to fix Rhode Island’s crumbling schools. Additionally, he made sure the plan would benefit local taxpayers by increasing Cumberland’s state reimbursement rate and fighting to include the Lincoln High School renovation among those projects receiving incentives.

## Investing in Cumberland and Lincoln

A lifelong resident of northern Rhode Island, Ryan has worked to ensure state resources are invested in our community’s roads, bridges, water lines, and parks. Recently, he secured \$300,000 for the revitalization of Diamond Hill Park and successfully advocated for a \$400,000 DEM grant to acquire open space at Mercy Woods

## Advocating for Seniors

Not only has Ryan worked to eliminate state income taxes on social security and other retirement income, he has also doubled state funding to senior centers. Recognizing the importance of strong senior services, Ryan has called for the construction of a new Cumberland Senior Center and will work to increase senior services offered throughout the state.
